Terms of reference for the NACP Nuclear Medicine Physics Committee (NMPC)

Drafted 27.1.2025 by the NACP NMPC

Approved by the NACP council on May 20th 2025

Aim

NACP NMPC shall initiate Nordic networks and collaborations within the field of nuclear medicine physics to meet the demands from the nuclear medicine community and to improve the different aspects of nuclear medicine physics in the Nordic countries.

The Committee shall

- Promote the implementation of an infrastructure to simplify mutual Nordic activities within the field of nuclear medicine physics
- Promote the field of nuclear medicine physics, and inform about the opportunity of a career in nuclear medicine physics at relevant events
- Distribute information about Nordic and international CPD courses in nuclear medicine physics, and make suggestions for new courses when a need is identified
- Support ways to share knowledge, procedures and facilitate contact within the field of nuclear medicine physics
- Promote collaboration between physicists within nuclear medicine and physicists as well as clinicians working in other clinical fields
- Aim at organizing educational webinars to achieve the aforementioned goals
- Aim at organizing educational seminars in conjunction with congresses of the NACP or the national medical physics societies

The Committee

- Consists of five members; one member is being nominated by each of the national member organizations (NMOs) in Denmark, Finland, Iceland, Norway, and Sweden.
- Each member is nominated for a period of two years, and can be re-nominated only once. Exceptions can be made if there are no volunteers from a specific country.
- Is directed by a leader elected by the committee. The leader shall:
 - Coordinate the work within the committee
 - Be the link between the NACP council and the committee
 - In January every year report about the work to the NACP council
 - Be responsible for promoting the work in the committee on the NACP web together with the Webmaster
- The exchange of information will be performed mainly via e-mail correspondence and through online meetings, since the committee has no financial resources
- Should aim at meeting in person once a year, preferably on one of the conferences or courses organized by NACP

The committee may find the need to evaluate and possibly revise the terms of reference after gaining some practical experience during the first years of practice.
